

CAST BIOS

J. Lance Wilkinson (The Motorist) is happy to tread the boards once again since returning to the stage 7 years ago following a 43 year hiatus since high school. Prior appearances include "Sitting Bull" ("Annie Get Your Gun"), "Kringelin", "Rich Man" and "Phil" (Gypsy), ensemble ("9 to 5 The Musical", "The Wedding Singer"), "Duke Frederick" ("As You Like It"), "Henry" ("Murder Me Always"), Sheriff Willie Rackham ("Murd-ARR!!! Pirates of the Salty Dog") and the Press Corp (Dead Tuesday), all with State College Community Theater, as well as "Chapuys' Attendant" ("A Man For All Seasons") and ensemble ("Mama Mia!") with Nittany Theater, and in several PSU Student Films. He originated the role "Drunk Messenger" in Jerry Sawyer's "Arthur and Merlin", and spoke and sang the "voice" of the mute Zechariah in Jerry's "Mary and Elizabeth: A Conversation." Rob Arnold (Professor Plum) is excited to return to the stage with SCCT this season! Rob was most recently seen in Dead Tuesday as Bob Boudreaux. You've likely seen Stefanie in one of the 8 murder mysteries and 2 stage plays she has performed in since 2014; some of her favorite past roles include Bonny in Murd-arr! Pirates of the Salty in 2021, Margot Wendice in SCCT's Dial M for Murder in 2019, and Cassie Cooper in Nittany Theatre's Rumors! in 2018. She has also directed three murder mysteries, including most recently Dead Tuesday in February, and has built set pieces for several productions. Off-stage, Stefanie works at Penn State, teaches statistics, plays soccer, hosts board game nights, and enjoys time with her family. Rob Burns (Wadsworth/Costume Designer/Set Construction/Props Master) has been involved in community theater since 2004. Of the 14 shows he did with Stone Arch Players over the subsequent 12 years, his favorite role was Tony in 'Dial M for Murder' in 2010. He went on to join Mifflin County Community Christmas Musical as George Bailey in 'It's a Wonderful Life,' and Scrooge in 'A Christmas Carol.' He joined SCCT in 2017, served on multiple production staffs as director and producer, and was elected secretary in 2018. He played Claudius in SCCT's Hamlet that summer, was elected President in 2019, and reprised Claudius with Studio 570 that summer. He debuted at the Boal Barn playhouse as Nick in 'Over the River and Through the Woods' in May 2019, and reprised his role as Tony in SCCT's production of 'Dial M for Murder' that September. Last season, Rob was cast in Molly Howard Is No More, 9 to 5 The Musical, and (the cancelled) Glass Menagerie. He ended the 2021 season as Costumer for Murd-arr: Pirates of the Salty Dog, and usually fulfills various production staff roles for most shows. Rob has worked for BK Medical for 16 years, and lives in Reedsville with his wife, Kerry.
